- ORGANIZES SELF, MATERIALS, & BELONGINGS
- **PARTICIPATES IN GROUP ACTIVITIES**
- RESPECTS RIGHTS, DIVERSITY, FEELINGS, & PROPERTY OF OTHERS
- RESPECTS SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT & MATERIALS
- SHOWS POSITIVE ATTITUDE TOWARD LEARNING
- STRIVES FOR QUALITY WORK
