We need your help to make sure all children learn them!

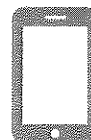
SKILLS AND BEHAVIORS THAT PROMOTE LEARNING

- ★ WORKS & PLAYS COOPERATIVELY WITH OTHERS

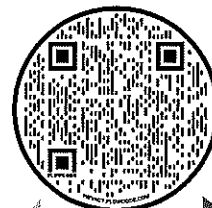
