Hamilton Disston Elementary GOALS

At least 70% of Kindergarten students and 50% of 1st and 2nd grade students will score at target by the Spring AIMSweb assessment.

At least 90% of all students in grades 6-8 will have 0 out of school suspensions, as evidenced by Qlik and KPI Dashboard

No more than 25% of students in Grades 3, 5 and 8 will score Below Basic on the ELA PSSA with incremental checks through STAR assessment

No more than 20% of students in Grades 3 through 8 will score Below Basic on the Math PSSA with incremental checks through Friday Flash / PSSA math style probes.

At least 50% of students will attend 95% or more days as evidenced by Qlik and KPI Dashboard
